
Syntax and semantics

Default assumptions for syntax and semantics:

- Syntax: The syntactic analysis of a sentence reflects the structure of a sentence as justifiable through constituent tests, and, usually, through further considerations of syntactic theory.
- Semantics: The semantic analysis of a sentence is expressed in predicate logic with generalized quantifiers.
